SCHEDULE OF HARBOUR CHARGES

By virtue of the powers contained in the Harbours Act 1964, the Grampian Regional Council (Harbours) Order 1987 and the Pilotage Act 1987, Aberdeenshire Council have revised the dues chargeable by them at the undernoted Harbours and the revised maximum dues are listed in the following schedule.

Other charges, to which the provisions of the said Act and Orders do not apply, are also listed in the schedule.

The schedule shall have effect from 1 April 2023

SCHEDULE OF MAXIMUM HARBOUR RATES AND DUES

A.1 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A.1.1 Any item or service not covered by these Rates and Dues will be assessed by the Harbours Service and the Project Manager shall have the power to set an appropriate Rate or Fee for that Item or Service.
- A.1.2 It must be further noted that any legitimate cost incurred by the Harbours Service on behalf of any vessel, skipper, owner, or agent whether requested or not by that person/vessel shall be recharged to that person/vessel including any administrative or service costs so associated.
- A.1.3 For any Credit Notes generated not through fault of the Harbour Service, a charge of £30.00 will be applied
- A.1.4 VAT shall be charged at the current rate on vessels under 15 gross registered tons, where the vessels is not designed or has been adapted for recreational / pleasure activities.
- A.1.5 All reference to length in the Rates & Dues shall mean registered length
- A.1.6 No refunds will be applied
- A.1.7 Please note that legal action for debt recovery may affect your ability to obtain credit in the future.
- A.1.8 If legal action is required to recover any debt due to Aberdeenshire Council under these Rates and Dues the cost of such action including all administrative and ancillary costs shall be due to be recovered from the debtor.
- A.1.9 Please note that legal action for debt recovery may result in you being blacklisted and may affect your ability to obtain credit in the future.

A.2 CARGO VESSELS

- A.2.1 Cargo dues shall be payable prior to the shipment or discharge of any goods unless the shipper or consignee has been granted credit terms by the Council. The Council reserve the right to retain any goods in respect of which the cargo dues have not been paid, and that at the cost of the shipper or the consignee, as the case may be, until the dues and costs thereby incurred by the Council are settled in full.

A.3 BERTHING FEES FOR FISHING VESSELS (MACDUFF)

- A.3.1 For any vessel for which no composition fee has been paid, the rate payable on each entry, valid for 1 week or part thereof or as otherwise specifically arranged, shall be as stated in Table B.1.
- A.3.2 If, after paying the composition fee, the vessel ceases to regularly land fish, each entry to the harbour shall be charged in accordance with Table B.1
NOTE - To qualify for composition fee the vessel must have 3 consecutive entries to the Harbour.
- A.3.3 Masters of vessels or their agents paying harbour dues under any of the above categories who engage in commercial fishing shall be required to declare the value of the catch to the Harbourmaster within 7 days of landing and to pay the appropriate fish landing dues either directly to the Council or to a fish salesman or purchaser, duly authorised by Aberdeenshire Council to collect such dues.

A.4 COMMERCIAL OR CHARTER OPERATIONS

- A.4.1 The methods and process of levying the above fees shall be determined by the Service Manager or the Harbours Sub-Committee.
Similarly, no discount or reduction in this Rate or payment may be given without the written permission of the Service Manager.
Any operator who wishes clarification of the above shall seek this from the Harbours Service who shall consult the Head of Roads and Landscape Services and shall advise that operator which category of payment applies.
The decision of the Head of Roads and Landscape Services shall be final in that case.

A.5 COMPOSITION FEE FOR TRADITIONAL BERTHING, COMPOUND & HARDSTANDING

- A.5.1 All reference to length in this section shall mean "length overall".
- A.5.2 Please note that by signing an application for a berth all customers have confirmed their acceptance that there will be no refunds if the berth is vacated before the end of the period covered by that payment.
- A.5.3 All Berthing Fees MUST be paid in full before 1st April in any year for summer or twelve months berthing and before 1st October where winter berthing in Harbour or Compound is required.
- A.5.4 Supply of Water (Under present circumstances this is VAT free)
- A.5.5 If a vessel is occupying a berth not allocated to them, there will be a daily rate charged for the period the vessel is in the un-approved berth, irrespective of whether they have paid the berthing charge.

A.6 SINGLE ENTRY (AND ROVER TICKET)

- A.6.1 All payments will be due on entry and in advance for extended stays in any and all Harbours.
